

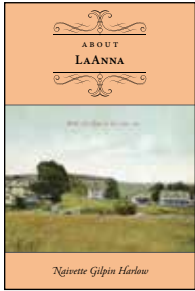

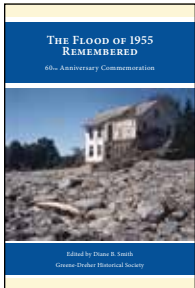

With photographs, map, and genealogy charts. 64 pages, softcover. \$11.32.

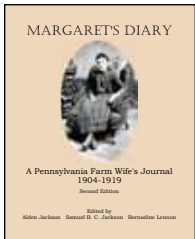

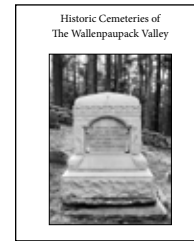


### **Growing up in Greene Township— COLLECTED ESSAYS OF EDWARD PARSONS**

After his retirement as a high school science teacher, Edward Parsons (1926–2014) wrote a series of essays that reflect on a life “rich in work, family, and the influence of grandparents.” An astute observer of rural life, he tells about growing up on a small dairy farm during the Depression, serving in the Army during World War II, and returning home to begin a career and raise a family. **Margaret's Diary, A Pennsylvania Farmwife's Journal, 1904–1919**, 2nd Edition, edited by Alden and Sam Jackson and Bernadine Lennon. 2011. The diaries of Margaret Gilpin Hazelton, Greentown, detail daily life in rural Wayne and Pike Counties between 1904 and 1919 and give us a rare glimpse into a time of great change in America, as seen through the eyes of a farm wife. 523 pages, softcover. \$22.64.



**Historic Cemeteries of The Wallenpaupack Valley** by Ruth Altemier. 2014. History, photographs, and descriptions of cemeteries in Greene and Dreher Townships, with highlights of notable people who are buried there. Map and directions for self-guided driving tour. 24 pages, softcover. \$6.60.

**Falling Feathers** by Peggy Bancroft. 1991. A study of the Native American presence in the Pocono Mountain region through stories, tales, legends, and historical fact. 151 pages, softcover. \$9.43.

**All Roads Lead Home** by Peggy Bancroft, 1995. The story of Newfoundland from the first people who walked the land, the Lenape, to the earliest European settlers, to events leading up to the 1960s. 59 pages, softcover. \$9.43.

**Distant Days: Adventures in Remembering** by Peggy Bancroft, 2002. Collection of more than 50 articles and essays on varied topics related to local and regional history. 205 pages, softcover. \$9.43.
